#### **Academic:**

The school is living up to its name, mission and the standard already attained. In all classes from JSS 1 to SSS 3, great effort was made to ensure that the scheme of work for the session was covered and the students have excellent grip on various topics taught. The tripple efforts of parents, teachers and students could be seen in the improved academic performance of each child. Also our students in JSS 3 and SSS 3 were successfully registered for and participated in all the appropriate external standard examinations.

In the UTME (JAMB), we achieved 97.3% success as 36 out of 37 registered candidates from the school achieved university cut-off mark this year. At present, as we await the release of the result of other examinations with high hope. We will continue to maintain high quality teaching and learning process in a serene and conducive academic environment where each child is loved, cared for and valued.

### Facilities:

The place of appropriate instructional materials in the teaching and learning process is well understood in the school. Hence, to ensure effective and balanced teaching and learning in the school, the management is constantly improving the existing facilities and adequately procuring relevant modern materials to aid teachers in their work. During the session, our science laboratories were upgraded. Also school sank new boreholes in the school to solve the problems associated with erratic water supply. Apart from that along with our existing generators inverters were installed to enhance the availability of power in the school.

To ensure the children eat well for proper development the school serves students optional, well planned balanced daily cooked meal.

## **Discipline/Punctuality/Neatness:**

Our rules and regulations are explicit and every student is expected to be upright both in and outside the school. To maintain high moral tone already achieved by the school, we want to strongly appeal to all our parents to ensure that their children come to school regularly, punctually and their children come to school in the approved uniforms – black shoes and black socks with regular uniform, while white canvas (no colour

stripe) and white socks go with sport wears. The use of unapproved cardigan is not allowed. Note to ensure compliance we will seize any unapproved material combined with the school uniform.
